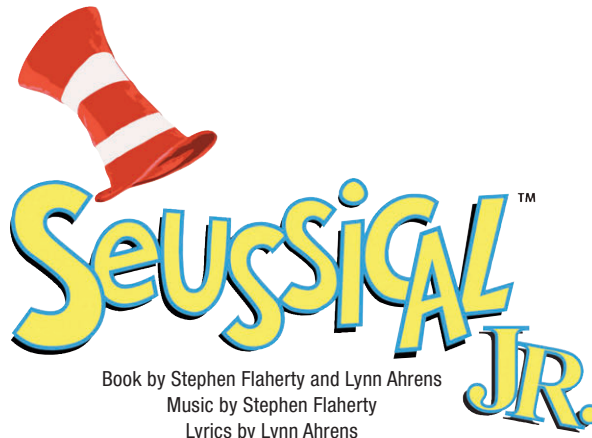

Oh, the things you can think and do to get ready to audition for this energetic Seuss-ified musical! Director Todd Espeland, Music Director Julie Davis, and Choreographer Kris Allemang Stahl will help participants learn everything they will need to know to succeed at auditions. Julie will teach the musical selection that will be required of all participants to sing at the audition and they will get tips, tricks, and immediate feedback to help improve their singing technique. Kris will teach choreography that may be used at the audition as well as some steps that are in the style of the show. There are some big characters in this production so Todd will also coach participants in readings so they can get a better feel for these fantastical, larger than life characters that make up *Seussical Jr!*
