## CASTING

Seeking a Company (actors and production crew) of approximately 50 youth (For onstage roles and production crew opportunities which may include Props, Costumes/Make-Up, Paint, Lighting, Sound, Assistant Stage Management and a Scenery Building crew) ages 9 through a Senior in High School. Students must have turned 9 on or before the day of the first rehearsal. (January 21, 2019)

## REQUIREMENTS

Those wishing to audition are required to register in advance for either the **Sunday, December 15th** or **Monday, December 16th** audition date.

- A parent or guardian is required to attend the first half hour of auditions.
- Those auditioning for onstage roles will be taught a song at auditions, may be taught a dance combination and may be asked to read from the script.
- Those auditioning for crew positions will be asked to listen to designer presentations, speak to designers/technicians and indicate interest for specific crews.
